Scholarship Deadline: Monday, April 15, 2024 at 11:59 PM ET

DC Pearls III Foundation, working together with Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated®, Rho Mu Omega Chapter annually awards college scholarships to assist Washington, D.C. high school graduates to continue their education at a Historically Black College or University (HBCU). Scholarships will be awarded to students who will be matriculating at a Historically Black College or University (HBCU) beginning in the fall of 2024.

Scholarships will be awarded to students who demonstrate academic excellence, leadership skills, and community service. Applicants must meet the general eligibility requirements and qualifications of the individual scholarship for which they apply. Applicants may apply for as many scholarships as possible but can only be awarded one scholarship.

Description and Disbursement of Scholarship Award Funds

The General, Presidential, Linda Latney, and STEM scholarship recipients will each receive an initial \$5,000 scholarship to be applied to the recipient's college/university account. The recipient may be eligible for up to \$1,000 scholarship renewal for an additional three (3) years, based on the availability of funds and academic record.

The Arts, Angela Ducker Richardson Memorial Scholarship, The Edward and Kizzie Hayes Educational Scholarship, the Sensational Silver Stars Scholarship, and A Diamond, Pearl, and Golden Opportunity Scholarship are NOT renewable.

General Eligibility Requirements for Scholarship Applicants and Recipients

Interested applicants must meet the following criteria to qualify for every scholarship award:

- Be a U. S. Citizen or permanent legal resident of the United States of America, and a District of Columbia resident.
- Be a high school graduating senior who lives and attends a public, private, or charter school in the District of Columbia and will graduate between May 2024 and August 2024.
- Have a minimum high school grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 or better based on a 4.0 scale.
- Demonstrate academic achievement. (Official Transcript)
- Demonstrate volunteer commitment of time and leadership skills to support the community.
- Be accepted and attend a Historically Black College or University in Fall 2024 as a freshman and take classes on campus, for the entire year.

Each scholarship recipient must be actively enrolled full-time as a freshman in an HBCU in Fall 2024 and for the full academic year without interruption with the following exceptions: long-term illness, emergency, or military service. Recipients are responsible for providing proof of their respective college/university enrollment. Proof of enrollment should be sent to the email address provided on the scholarship award letter. It must come from the college's/university's Registrar's Office.

To receive an initial scholarship award, students must submit a "**Verification of Enrollment Form**". This verification must be submitted after the student arrives at the college/university and the student has registered for Fall 2024 classes. To be eligible for a renewal scholarship, students must submit an official transcript that verifies the student's current GPA of 3.0 or higher.

All requests for scholarship awards (initial and renewals) must be submitted to the DC Pearls III Foundation Scholarship Committee by September 15th of each school year. Award money will be electronically transferred directly to the college/ university to be applied to the student's account. The school routing number, account number, and the student's identification should be noted to ensure proper deposit into the student's account. Renewal requests must be submitted, with proof of a continuous 3.0 cumulative grade point average (official transcript).

Additionally, applicants should be available to attend the planned Scholarship Awards Ceremony to receive your scholarship award.

How to Apply

All application packets and supporting documentation must be submitted together (uploaded at one time), must come from the student's school counselor, and submitted no later than **Monday, April 15, 2024, at 11:59 pm ET.**

Late and incomplete application packets submitted by the school counselor will not be considered or reviewed. Application packets will not be returned to the student. The Scholarship Committee is not under any obligation to notify students of late or incomplete application packets.

		Type your Personal Statement , 300-500 words, Times New Roman font, double-spaced, 12 pt. font size, correct spelling, and grammar.
		Complete the Essay Question on the application that is specific to each scholarship application
		(300-500 words, Times New Roman font, double-spaced, 12 pt. font size, correct spelling, and grammar).
		Include or make provision for three (3) Letters of Recommendation. One letter of recommendation should be from a counselor or school administrator. The other two letters of recommendation must be from someone very familiar with the applicant (academically and personally) but should not be from the applicant's parents or relatives. For an application to be vetted and reviewed, all recommendation letters must be on letterhead , addressed to the DC
		Pearls III Foundation Scholarship Committee, dated February 2024 – April 2024 , and must be signed . Applications will not be reviewed and rated if not submitted as stated above. No exceptions.
		There is no need to supply a picture with this application. Scholarship recipients will be asked to supply a HEADSHOT-ONLY picture when they are notified. By supplying a picture, recipients give our organization permission to use your picture in print publications, online publications, presentations, websites, and social media. No royalties, fees, or other compensation shall be provided.
		Provide signatures of the applicant and parents/guardian if the applicant is under 21 years of age.
		Submit the completed application by uploading all the required supporting documents. However, if your school requires an administrator or counselor to submit your transcript and/or letter of recommendation, please upload a PLACE HOLDER DOCUMENT in those fields that just include your name, school, and the name of the scholarship for which you are applying. Please allow ample time for your school counselor or administrator to submit transcripts and letters of recommendation.
		After submitting your scholarship application, contact the school counselor or administrator
		directly to let them know you have applied for our scholarship. Forward to them a copy of the email you will receive after submitting your scholarship application. Ask them to email your official transcript and letter of recommendation to scholarships@rhomuomega.org

Extraordinary Sensational Performer (ESP) Book Award

The ESP Book Award Scholarship provides one student with supplemental funds to purchase books and other supplies needed for college-level coursework. The ESP Book Award is funded by donations from members of 33 ESP. As a result, the amount may vary year to year from \$250 to \$500.

The Ebony Mix/Lydia Hallum's Memorial Scholarship

Ebony Mix/Lydia Hallum's Memorial Scholarship is an additional scholarship with a minimum amount of \$500 and is awarded to the scholarship applicant with the highest GPA of all applications received.
