- 3. What does Jesus teach and instruct the disciples to do? How can we apply this passage to our everyday life?
- 4. John Wesley taught these three lessons: Do no harm; Do good; and Stay in love with God. How does this relate to Jesus' teaching concerning discipleship?
- 5. In John 4:35-36, how does Jesus' perspective of the harvest differ from that of the disciples?
- 6. What does this passage teach us about the importance of discipleship and seizing opportunities to share our story with others?
- 7. How do these two passages relate and complement each other?
- 8. What prevents us from being better at being laborers in the harvest?
- 9. How can we cultivate a greater sense of compassion and urgency in our own lives?


