Hark! The Herald Angels Sing Luke 2:10-11

The carol we now know as Hark! The Herald Angels sing was originally written by Charles Wesley, with the original title of "Hark, How All the Welkin Rings". This poem/song was later altered by preacher George Whitefield to become the modern version we know today. The melody used today is not original to the hymn. Today's melody was adapted from the music from a 19th-century German composer, Felix Mendelssohn, by William H. Cummings to better fit the lyrics Wesley had written. The hymn is based on the biblical account in Luke 2:8-14 of angels announcing the birth of Jesus to the shepherds.

- 1. What is the meaning of the word "Hark" and why is it fitting to be used as the first word?
- 2. Discuss the phrase "God and sinners reconciled". What does this mean to you and how is peace with God achieved through Jesus?
- 3. What does the song reveal about the birth of Jesus?
- 4. Discuss the importance of the angels announcing the Messiah's birth to shepherds.
- 5. How can we be more like the angels or the shepherds by listening to God's message and going to see Jesus?
- 6. Meditate on the phrases in the hymn and seek to apply them in your life. How does Christ bring peace and healing to you?
- 7. What does it mean to have your heart as God's home?

Hark! The herald angels sing...and I pray we listen to them announcing the birth of Christ for the world...for you and me...that we may all better understand his joy, hope, peace and love this Christmas!


