Friends,

As I reflect on my tenth year of pastoral ministry, the culmination of a decade, all of which I've been so profoundly blessed to journey and serve with all of you at Kingstowne,

I can't help but stand in awe at the kind of faith that's been required to grow a church like Kingstowne, and how that faith has been owned and lived by all of you, who give faithfully of yourselves and of your finances, to make God's vision possible and see God's vision through to the defining moment now before us.

By God's grace, made real through your steadfast faith and support, as well as through the generous partnership we've continued to cultivate with Virginia Hills Church,

the Kingstowne Communion will make our *final move* this year to our permanent home at 6507 Telegraph Road - a beautiful, new building set in the foreground of the new Brightview Senior Living community - upon completion of construction and permitting for occupancy (currently on track for May 2026).

At the dawn of this new decade at Kingstowne, and with a mix of excitement and longing, nostalgia and even a little angst, I've found myself clinging to this familiar promise and reminder from Jesus:

"Don't let your hearts be anxious. In my house, there are many dwelling places. If it were not so, would I have told you that I go to prepare a place for you? Where I am, there you will be, and you know the way to the place I am going." (John 14:1-4)

In every age, season, and storm, these words have served to steady God's Church; and lately I've sensed them timelessly steadying us now, as we prepare and pivot from being a mobile, community-centered church to establishing a permanent, prominent presence at the center of our community.

For years, we've been a church on the move – rolling cases off trailers at daybreak, turning cafeterias into sanctuaries, and praying that borrowed spaces would become holy ground; and at every courageous, creative, and collaborative turn, God has met us there. Amidst metal chairs and folded tables, in spite of locked doors and spotty wifi, flat tires and frozen hitches, God has renewed us, inspired us, saved and healed us, and sent us out.

And so to every set-up and tear-down saint: thank you. Your faithfulness has been the scaffolding to countless encounters with God's grace, endless stories of the kind of fear-defying faith for which the world longs.

And now, amidst cultural and political climates dominated by fear (economic uncertainty, churning headlines, all the "what ifs" that keep us awake at night), Jesus is speaking again, to us, "Don't let your hearts be anxious" – not as a way to minimize our questions, but rather to maximize God's presence and our willingness to trust in it, move with it, build our hope on it, stake our faith in it, forecast our future from it.

That's why we've named this crucial 2026 stewardship season at the Kingstowne our *Forecasting Faith* Campaign.

Forecasting is not pretending there aren't dark clouds on the horizon; it is choosing to read the sky with the way and hope of Jesus in view. Fear seeks to measure the pressure around us; but faith always seeks to measure God's presence with us, God's Spirit within us.

Yes, God is *preparing a place for us*; but God is also *preparing us* for a place - preparing us so that we might then prepare a place for others to lay down their fear, be renewed in their faith, and come fully alive by the love of God in Jesus.

And, that's also why this beautiful, new building will never be the *end in itself*. This gift and opportunity with Virginia Hills Church is not our trophy. For the Kingstowne Communion, a church that exists to the gather people into communion with Jesus, this building will be our table –

a table with many-a-leaf (a house with many dwelling places), where children will learn the name of Jesus, youth will find belonging, grief will be held, marriages will be healed, food will be shared, neighbors will become friends, and worship will overflow into courageous, creative, collaborative community transformation.

And Jesus reminds us, "You know the way to the place I am going." It's true, we do. This is the way of Jesus, and has always and will continue to be the way of the Kingstowne Communion: ever-extending God's table - courageously, creatively, and collaboratively - until Kingdom comes.

Therefore, I invite you to join me in Forecasting Faith in the future of this, our beloved church:

- First, spend time reviewing the enclosed 2025 annual report and give thanks to God with
 me for the incredible community impact and congregational growth we've witnessed this year,
 especially as the result of establishing the Neighborkind Collective; hiring our beloved Qualitra
 Brown over family ministries; and witnessing walls go up as we prepare and await our move
 with Virginia Hills in late spring 2026.
- Second, consider the 2025 and 2026 financials enclosed, our current 2025 year-end deficit
 and limited remaining cash assets; as well as the required increases in expenses projected for
 2026 and the two possible increased budgets proposed for next year.

 Third, in a posture of prayer before God, consider what truly Forecasting Faith in the future of this church would look like and ask of you:

<u>Ask yourself</u>: What is *mine* (*my responsibility as a steward of this church*) to give? Am I giving what is *mine to give*, what I uniquely *can give*, or that which is a *true sacrifice of worship?*

<u>Ask God</u>: Lord, how are you leading me in this season?? How are you calling me to live without fear and forecast faith in your hope-filled future?

Finally, make your 2026 financial pledge in an act of worship on Commitment Sunday(s), December 7 & 14, 2025 (following the instructions included on the final page of this report); and, consider, also, increasing your December 2025 giving to reflect your 2026 pledge, to help us finish the year strong and replenish our cash assets.





CURRENT FINANCIALS: BUDGET VS. ACTUALS




