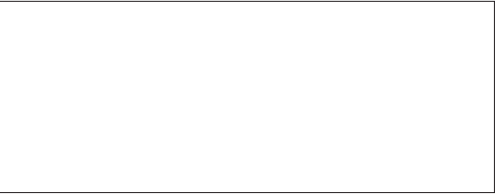

You might not have known, but most Fridays this past school year, I served as a substitute teacher. Now don’t worry—I have no desire to be a full-time educator in the classroom. I love FBC Lawton, and I know without a doubt that I’m called specifically to children’s ministry. I don’t know exactly what I was expecting when I signed up, but what I didn’t expect was to witness, firsthand, how our FBC kiddos are truly shining the light of Jesus in their schools.

It was always funny when I would walk into a new classroom and see familiar faces from church. At first, they’d look so confused, but that confusion quickly turned into big smiles, and I can’t tell you how much joy that brought me. Over time, I began to notice something special—our FBC kids carried themselves differently than the rest of the students and I mean that in the best way possible.

One day one of the co-teachers that I was with shared a special story with them. She told me about a student in her class, one of our FBC kiddos, gave her a handwritten note with a Bible verse on it. The teacher

explained that she has been teaching for years, and no student had ever done anything like that for her before. That small gesture encouraged her deeply.

The everyday decisions we make how we speak, how we treat others, and how we carry ourselves matter. Each child’s mission field is their school, their sports team, their dance class—wherever they spend their time. We talk about the kids missions field every time we meet.

If our kids are living on mission in their schools, what are we doing to support them? I am really excited that this year though our VBS offering we are going to help foster spaces for our kids to go to work for the gospel! This year’s VBS offering is going to look a little different. We’ll be collecting our offering to support the school systems in Lawton and the surrounding areas. I know that is not what typically our VBS offering goes to. Typically, our VBS offerings go to support mission organizations or church plants. Those are incredibly valuable, and we should support those too, but as I’ve prayed over this year’s offering, I feel strongly that this is the right direction.

Supporting our school systems is one tangible way we can support our little missionaries out on the field. How cool would it be to see a pizza party turn into a gospel conversation? Whether it’s classroom supplies, encouragement for teachers, or meeting basic needs, our offering will plant seeds in the very mission fields where our kids are already working.

This is more than just a financial gift it’s a step in supporting and recognizing what our kids are already doing. I can’t wait to see what God does through VBS to our schools.
