

## MIRACLES: Signs and Wonders

March 23rd, 2025



### DAY 1: EMBRACING GOD'S MIRACULOUS POWER READING: MARK 4:35-41

Jesus calming the storm reminds us that God's power is active in our world today. Just as the disciples were filled with awe, we too can experience wonder at God's miraculous work.

Reflect on areas in your life where you need to trust God's power. How might surrendering control to Him open doors for miracles in your circumstances?

Ask God to increase your faith and expectancy for His supernatural intervention.

## DAY 2: THE GREATEST MIRACLE - CHRIST'S INCARNATION AND RESURRECTION

READING: JOHN 1:1-14, 1 CORINTHIANS 15:1-8

The incarnation (Jesus becoming a man) and resurrection of Jesus are the foundational miracles of our faith. God became flesh, dwelt among us, died for our sins, and rose victorious over death. This ultimate display of divine power gives us confidence in God's ability to work miracles today.

How does the reality of Christ's resurrection impact your daily life? Pray for a renewed appreciation of this miraculous cornerstone of our faith.

#### DAY 3: EMPOWERED TO SERVE

**READING: 1 PETER 4:10-11, 1 CORINTHIANS 12:4-11** 

God equips each believer with spiritual gifts to serve others and glorify Him. These gifts, including miracles, are meant to be used for the common good.

Consider what gifts God may have given you. Are you using them fully for His purposes?

Ask God to reveal any areas where you might be holding back, and pray for courage to step out in faith to use your gifts boldly.

## DAY 4: MIRACLES AS SIGNS OF GOD'S KINGDOM READING: MATTHEW 11:2-6, LUKE 11:14-20

Jesus' miracles were signs that God's kingdom was breaking into our world. Today, miracles continue to demonstrate that God's power is greater than any earthly authority or spiritual darkness.

Reflect on how you've seen God's kingdom advancing in your life or community.

Pray for eyes to recognize His work and for opportunities to participate in extending His kingdom influence.

## DAY 5: MIRACLES THAT GLORIFY GOD READING: JOHN 9:1-7, 35-38

The ultimate purpose of miracles is to bring glory to God and draw people to faith in Him. In healing the blind man, Jesus revealed God's power and compassion, leading to worship.

Consider how God's work in your life, miraculous or otherwise, can be a testimony to others.

Ask God to use your experiences, including any hardships, as a means to showcase His glory and draw others to Him.
