DAY 1: EQUIPPING FOR GOD'S PURPOSE READING: EPHESIANS 4:11-16

God has uniquely gifted each of us for a specific purpose within His church. Just as a body needs all its parts to function properly, the church needs each member to fulfill their role. Reflect on how you've been equipped by God. What spiritual gifts has He given you? How can you use these gifts to build up others in the faith?

Remember, your contribution, no matter how small it may seem, is vital to the overall health and growth of the church. Today, pray for discernment in recognizing your gifts and for courage to use them for God's glory.

DAY 2: LIVING OUT YOUR FAITH

READING: TITUS 2:7-10


Our faith is not meant to be kept private, but to be lived out in a way that adorns the gospel. How we conduct ourselves in our daily lives - at work, in our neighbourhoods, with our families - can make the teachings of God attractive to others.

Consider areas of your life where your faith might be more visible. Are there ways you can "show good faith" in your interactions today? Pray for opportunities to demonstrate God's love and truth through your actions, making the gospel attractive to those around you.

DAY 3: THE POWER OF UNITY IN CHRIST READING: 1 CORINTHIANS 12:12-27

The church is described as a body with many parts, each essential and interconnected. This unity in diversity reflects God's design for His people. How have you experienced the beauty of this unity in your church community? Reflect on times when you've been supported by others in the body of Christ, and times when you've been able to support others.

Today, consider reaching out to someone in your church family - perhaps someone you don't know well - to encourage them or offer support. Pray for a deepening sense of unity and love within your church community.

DAY 4: GROWING IN SPIRITUAL MATURITY READING: COLOSSIANS 1:28-2:3

Spiritual growth is a lifelong journey, and God desires for us to continually mature in our faith. This growth often happens through the equipping and teaching we receive in the church. Reflect on your own spiritual journey. How have you grown in your understanding and application of God's Word? What areas of your spiritual life still need development?

Today, commit to taking one specific step towards greater spiritual maturity, whether it's dedicating more time to Bible study, seeking out a mentor, or seeking to serve in a new capacity. Pray for God's wisdom and guidance in your spiritual growth.

DAY 5: MULTIPLYING GOD'S KINGDOM READING: MATTHEW 28:18-20 AND 2 TIMOTHY 2:2

Jesus' final command to His disciples was to go and make more disciples, teaching them to obey all He had commanded. This multiplication of faith is at the heart of the church's mission. Consider your own role in this great commission. Who has discipled you in your faith journey? Who might you be called to disciple or mentor? Reflect on the impact that spiritual multiplication can have - how one life touched by Christ can lead to many more being transformed.

Today, pray for opportunities to share your faith and invest in others' spiritual growth. Ask God to use you as an instrument in His plan to reach the world with the good news of Jesus Christ.
