Things are peaceful once again, but these types of events are increasingly more common around the world. Our Indonesian church leadership sent a letter to their pastors with good reminders that I want to summarize here.

1. We are called to be light and salt amidst the darkness of this time. 2. Jeremiah 29:7 reminds us to seek the peace and welfare of the nation and communities around us. 3. Public complaints and protests are a natural reaction to injustice. However, as followers of Christ, we are called to respond with wisdom and love. 4. We should not repay evil for evil, but overcome evil with good. (Romans 12:17-21) 5. Pray diligently for the leaders of the nation (1 Timothy 2:1-2). 6. Be a prophetic voice - dare to speak out truth and justice without violence. 7. Serve others - bless those who suffer from injustice and economic crisis. 8. Refrain from violence for- blessed are the peacemakers. 9. Our hope is not in a political system but in God.
