EVERYTHING BY PRAYER

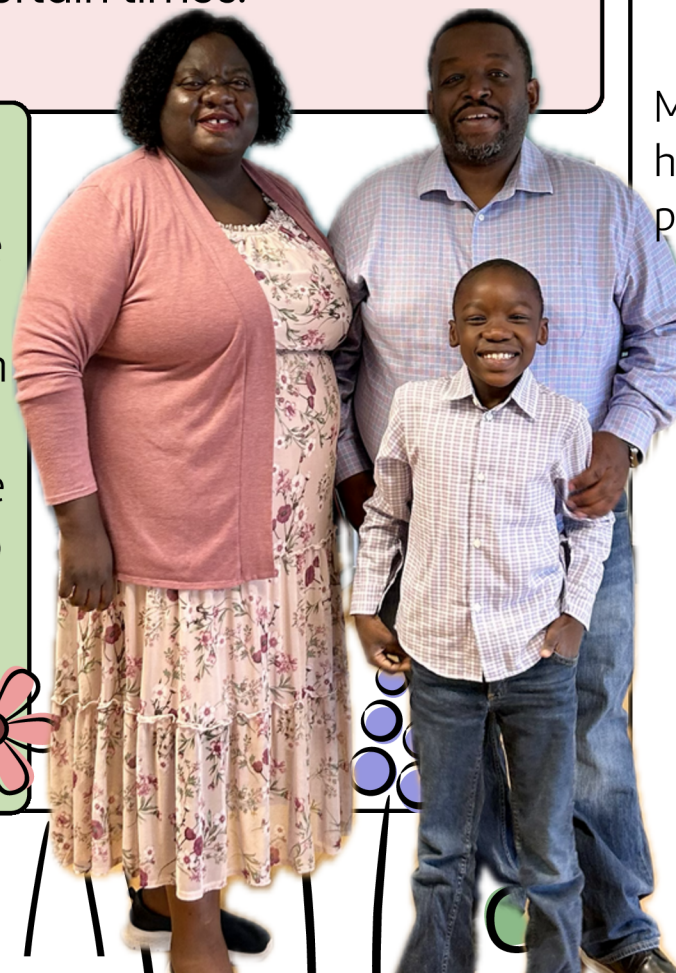
