

MISSION NEWS and CHRISTMAS JOY OFFERING:

Throughout 2019, Bethany has continued to support Guardian Angels Medical Service Dogs, again this Christmas season your Mission team has decided to support Guardian Angels Medical Service Dogs with our Christmas Joy Offering. Half of all monies raised during our Christmas services will be donated to GAMSD. As you can read below, from Jack Wagner, spokesperson



for the organization, he gives us an update on the new facility being built here:

First and foremost, thank you for all of the help and financial donations from Bethany Presbyterian Church in support of the mission of Guardian Angels Medical Service Dog's (GAMSD). With your support we have been able to help Veterans, First Responders and Civilians struggling with visible and invisible disabilities. The cost of raising and training a Medical Service Dog is \$25,000 and they are provided at no cost to the recipient. And many of our dogs have been placed with recipients here in Western Pa.

In 2019 we purchased 102 acres in Robinson Twp., Washington County to build our first campus outside of Williston, Florida. With a second campus we will be able to double the number of Medical Service Dogs to those in need.

Our plan is to break ground on the Pittsburgh Campus in 2020 and be up and operating in the fall of 2021. That is an aggressive schedule and is dependent on our ability to raise the necessary revenue. We are optimistic it will occur.

- GAMSD's have put together a very professional group to design and build the campus. Rocky Bleier Construction Group will be The Construction Management firm that directs and overseas the project. A service-disabled veteran owned company with significant experience and a great reputation.
- Avon-Graff is our architectural firm. They will provide professional expertise and innovative ideas for a campus environment. They are a well-respected company and are located in Sewickley, Pa.
- And finally our Civil Engineering & Site Development Firm is Lennon, Smith, Souleret. They are also local and have considerable experience with former surface mine property especially in the Airport Area.
