INTRODUCTION

Last week, we learned of our responsibility to work out our own salvation with fear and trembling. This is <u>not</u> to be confused with how we get saved. It is after salvation... and relates to how we ought to live. Today, we come to a significant portion of the scriptures dedicated to two servants – Timothy and Epaphroditus. As we look at their lives individually and then together, we will be moved by God to follow their example. God uses people to do extraordinary things. These men will teach us that our Lord uses different callings and faithfulness to build His church. This is God's message to you...

Important Note Epaphroditus is only mentioned in the Bible 2 times

and only this book.

- Philippians 2:25 Yet I supposed it necessary to send to you Epaphroditus, my brother, and companion in labour, and fellowsoldier, but YOUR MESSENGER and he that ministered to my wants.
- Philippians 2:30 Because for the work of Christ he was nigh unto death, NOT REGARDING HIS LIFE, to supply your lack of service toward me.

Important Note

To Paul, he was family in Christ, a partner in ministry, and a soldier in spiritual battle. Amen!
