FAMILY MATTERS

Pushing Back on the Loneliness Epidemic among Youth People

Many young adults feel deeply alone today. According to an article recently published on Rooted Ministry, about 73% of 18-22 year olds say they "sometimes or always feel alone." The loneliness crisis is serious. So serious that the surgeon-general equates its health impact to smoking 15 cigarettes a day! Sadly the many ways teens try to cope (scrolling endlessly online, adopting digital "identities," casual sex or pornography, or joining polarized social groups) often worsen the sense of isolation instead of easing it. What helps instead is real, gospel-rooted community: relationships grounded in faith, vulnerability, and belonging. As youth ministers and parents, our role is to help young people see that they're not "future church members," but an essential part of the church RIGHT NOW; loved, known, and valued; and to provide spaces where they truly connect with God and others.
