THEREFORE, SINCE WE ARE SURROUNDED BY SUCH A HUGE CROWD OF WITNESSES TO THE LIFE OF FAITH, LET US STRIP OFF EVERY WEIGHT THAT SLOWS US DOWN, ESPECIALLY THE SIN THAT SO EASILY TRIPS US UP. AND LET US RUN WITH ENDURANCE THE RACE GOD HAS SET BEFORE US. WE DO THIS BY KEEPING OUR EYES ON JESUS, THE CHAMPION WHO INITIATES AND PERFECTS OUR FAITH.

**HEBREWS 12:1-2** 

#### **RUN YOUR RACE**

These are the words the Holy Spirit dropped in my heart while on a short vacation over New Years. I had been reflecting on 2024 and wondering what 2025 would have in store for me personally, for our family, and for our church. One morning I read these verses from Hebrews 12 and I heard the Holy Spirit so clearly say to me, "just run your race. Don't worry about things you cannot control, just focus and run your race."

As we approach our 10th anniversary as the Pastor's of Life Community Church, these verses have hit me a little bit differently than they did in years past. I realize that this part of my race is different than when we started nearly 10 years ago, and if I'm not careful I could "hit the wall"



like many runners do in a race. They get to the point of feeling drained, exhausted mentally and physically, and just want to quit. But here's the thing, the wall is almost always all mental, quitting when you "hit the wall" is a choice. And we all know what is on the other side of "the wall" right? A second wind. A second burst of energy and excitement to propel you towards the finish line.

#### "Don't worry about things you cannot control, just focus and run your race."

I don't want to hit the wall, I don't want to burn out, I don't even want to just trudge through the next part of the race just barely hanging on hoping to get to that second wind, I want to get my second wind and run this next season with the same excitement and passion as the first. And that's where the words of Hebrews 12 just won't leave me alone. There are some things I need to do, and I dare say there are some things all of us need to do as we run our race.

- 1) We need to quit comparing our race to everyone else's, and we need to stop criticizing the way they run their race.
- 2) We need to get rid of the extra weight that makes it hard to run our race successfully. It's not just willful sin that slows us down, we need to take care of ourselves mentally, physically and spiritually.
- 3) We need to keep our eyes on Jesus, who isn't just cheering us on, He is continually perfecting our faith.

I don't know what all of us need to do to run our race with endurance, but I do know a few things I need to do, and with God's help 2025 is going to be a year of stripping off mental, physical, and spiritual weight. Can I encourage you to come with me? Make 2025 a year of doing the hard work so we can run with endurance wherever God takes our race.

Thanks for loving our family so well for nearly a decade. I am so grateful my kids have been able to grow up in a church that is so loving.
