

# NINTH AVENUE CHURCH OF CHRIST

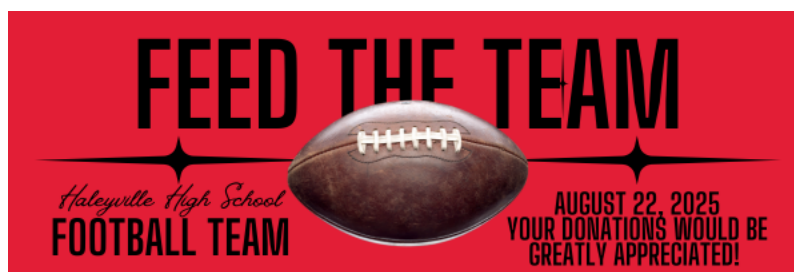

In Matthew 22:39, Jesus tells us the second greatest commandment is, “Love your neighbor as yourself.” A wonderful way to demonstrate care for others is to follow the Lord’s example and bear their burdens.

But the Lord intends something different for us. Our unique experiences equip us to help in ways that others cannot. Ask God how you can begin to help bear the burdens of your neighbors, and know you’ll be blessed mightily in the process.
