SERMON NOTES

"The Power of Your Story"

Sharing your story is very powerful. Most believers have never read the Bible. Most do not put a lot of stock in what the "experts" say.

They WILL listen to and believe your story of how God changed your life.

While we are thankful for the many ways the Gospel can be presented, and we are delighted every time the Gospel is shared, we believe the very best way to deliver the Good News of Jesus is when we deliver it in the vehicle of our own story. No one likes to be "preached at," but everyone likes a good story. It is very likely that you will be surprised about how your family and friends respond when you share your story with them.

We are also convinced that not only is sharing our story the most effective way to deliver the Good News, it is also the most Biblical way.

We don't see believers in the New Testament memorizing a script or a presentation, but again and again, we see them telling their encounter with Jesus Christ.

Today, we learn from the Apostle Paul how to practically share the Gospel as we share our story.
