### Sr. Adult Bible Study

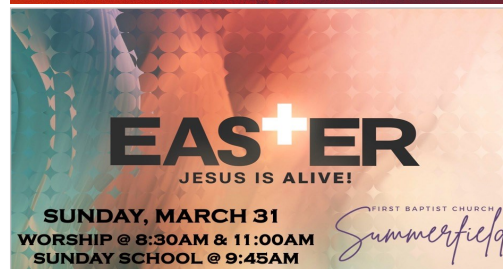
