Spiritual Covering

Introduction:

There is an inheritance reserved for those who understand the spiritual truth of covering. You are not covered to be controlled. You are covered to become better and to become whole. You are covered to extend the Kingdom of God beyond yourself. Covering is God's way of preserving destiny. It is through love, correction, alignment, and accountability that we are shaped for Kingdom impact. The danger? When you reject covering, you don't just reject man, you reject the method God uses to prepare and protect you. And without covering, you risk missing the inheritance that was always meant to be yours. We don't just need covering, we were designed for it. Where there's no order, there will be no anointing.

The devil is divisive. He's crafty enough to misrepresent covering so deeply that now anything resembling order, leadership, or pastoral care is labeled control. Also, because of abuse many people flinch at the very thing God uses to anchor and protect His people:

1. Accountability
2. Counsel
3. Correction

A Word for the Sheep

If you're in a church but you refuse accountability, covenant, and stewardship, you're not a sheep; you're a wolf in sheep's clothing. Wolves don't submit; they roam, they gather only to scatter and they don't receive correction – only compliments. The danger in this is many will forfeit destiny because they refuse to endure discipline.

The Danger of Living Uncovered

When you're uncovered, you wander, you war alone, you live exposed, you forfeit inheritance, covering and blessing. You reject the very process God uses to raise you. Humility isn't proven by how well you follow your own revelations. It's proven by how you submit to God through a vessel He has chosen.

God Still Uses People

Stop this nonsense of saying it's just me and the Holy Spirit. I don't need man when I have God. God still uses frail, broken vessels to lead, guide, and cover His people. He always has and He always will. Even Jesus called under-shepherds to tend His flock. It's not about man-worship. It's about divine order.

What Covering is and Isn't

Covering isn't telling your senior leader every move you make. Covering isn't obeying unbiblical commands, and covering isn't control. Covering is love, care, divine accountability where leaders stand before God, knowing your blood is on their hands if they lead you wrong. Control stunts you, but covering releases you.

The Call to You Agape Leaders

If you're not careful, some of you will forfeit mantles, calling, anointings and inheritances because you refuse to grasp the revelation of covering. I, Pastor Moss, call it revelation because not everyone will get it. But for those who do, it will unlock oil you can't manufacture on your own. Covering is woven through scripture. Parents cover, governments cover, Senior leaders cover and even Heaven itself covers. What you honor, you'll receive from.

Final Word

Stop calling correction control. Stop calling order manipulation. Stop calling biblical alignment abuse. Because where there's no order, there's no oil/anointing. And without oil, we have no fire, no power, and no endurance for what's ahead. We don't just need covering, we're designed for it!
