Giving was 17.4% more than budgeted for the month. Expenses were 8.44% less than budgeted for the month.

Thank you for your continuous, generous support of the missions at St. John Lutheran Church. Our finances continue to be strong. Giving is currently 0.30% more than budgeted for year-to-date while expenses are 15.44 less than budgeted for YTD.

In September, we spent approximately \$32,000 from our Capital Improvement dedicated account for the parking lot resealing, a new air conditioner & furnace for the sanctuary, paint for the octagon, and a water main repair in the yard. These were our first expenditures of 2025 from this account. As of 9/30/25, the official remaining balance in the Capital Improvement account was \$57,121.

Please consider making additional gifts to the Capital Improvement account as Council considers making improvements to a few spaces around the church, including the Lobby, the Octagon and/or making ADA improvements to some bathrooms.

Opening: Diane Menchhofer called the meeting to order. Matt Gilmore presented a devotional for the meeting.

Support Pastors' Report: Jennifer Barrett stated support pastors submitted their September reports.

Committee Reports: Pam Rasawehr and Moriah Plattner reported for the Worship Committee. The Worship Committee discussed preparations for All Saints Sunday, The Night of Promise (December 9th), and services on Christmas Eve. Mary Miller will be preaching all the Christmas Eve services for St. John Lutheran and St. Paul Lutheran; she recommended Christmas Eve service times at 4pm and 9pm at St. John Lutheran and at 6:30pm at St. Paul Lutheran. Next Worship Committee meeting scheduled for November 17th.

Lauren Fuelling gave a brief overview of the Community Engagement Committee. She stated the campfire night with corn hole tournament was a small yet enjoyable first event for their committee. The committee is currently busy with preparations for the Seventh Day Slumber concert by the lake on October 16th. They are working to find volunteers for the concert and possibly will reach out to the congregation.

Diane Menchhofer stated that the Nominating Committee has extended nominations for all upcoming church positions except Vice President. She is encouraging the Council to give consideration for who in the congregation may be a good candidate.

Matt Gilmore stated for the Audit Committee that the auditor contacted Don Trisel about the 2024 audit. The Audit Committee, Don, and the auditor are coordinating to fill where they knew some policies are lacking and considering cleaning up some accounts.

Karen Leugers, Sue Buxton, and Lauren Fuelling reported for the Mutual Ministries Committee. They stated that reviewing job descriptions with staff are completed. They are discussing how often to perform routine check-ins (considering quarterly or semi-annually).

Business Manager's Report: Don Trisel presented a summary of the September 2025 financial report. Don highlighted the budget is currently holding and work has begun for the 2026 church budget. Matt Gilmore motioned to accept the financial report; Chad Sapp seconded. Motion passed.

President's Report: Jennifer Barrett stated the CALL Committee reported preparing to interview a candidate and there may be a couple other potential candidates in the works.

Unfinished Business: Cheryl Heindel presented a mock-up of the conversion of the current nursery space into a new pastor's office and storage space in addition to reviewing layouts from last council meeting. Cheryl stated did not have pricing for the layouts; she will work on creating a budget for each potential project. Don Trisel advised Council that Capital Improvement Fund has seen a lot of activity this year paying for additional upkeep items like the sanctuary HVAC unit and repaying parking lots and recommends being aware of expenditures from this fund.

















The Book Club has chosen their next read.
