
WELCOME GUESTS!



SHAPED THROUGH SERVICE

It's been my privilege to serve in the ministries of LC3 over the years. Looking back, I've come to see that Kingdom work doesn't always require moving mountains. Sometimes it looks more like showing up, listening, praying, and walking alongside someone in your everyday life. Any act of service—big or small—can be sacred when done for the Lord.



One of the most meaningful ways I've served is through the Every Man A Warrior (EMAW) discipleship program. I've been a pod leader, part of the leadership team, and eventually took on the role of coordinating the program. Each role has allowed me to witness how God transforms men when they begin walking closely with Him. Watching a man commit his life to Jesus is one of the most powerful blessings I've experienced—and it never gets old.

Through EMAW, God also taught me more about my own calling, especially within my marriage. I gained a deeper understanding of what it means for my wife to be my ezer kenegdow—my suitable helper. That insight has brought new strength and grace into our relationship.

Another significant part of my journey has been leading the Colson Fellows program here at LC3. This study equipped me to see today's culture through a biblical lens. One of the truths that changed me most was the concept of imago Dei—that every person is made in the image of God. That realization has shifted how I see others, especially those who think differently than I do.

As part of the Colson program, we were asked to develop a personal mission plan—something tangible to carry forward. With Pastor Marc's support, I stepped into leading the Colson Fellows at LC3. That step, like so many others, reminded me that service isn't about perfection—it's about obedience.

Volunteering has stretched me, challenged me, and blessed me more than I ever imagined. It has deepened my faith, sharpened my understanding, and helped shape me into a more faithful servant of Christ.
