
WELCOME GUESTS!

MISSION IN FOCUS KOSSI & WHITNEY AKPI, FAMILY HOPE INTERNATIONAL, MALAWI

It is incredible to see what God has done in the last year. In March of 2024, we began building a house in faith that God was leading us to ministry in a village 2.5 hours north of Blantyre. Our Malawian ministry partners have ministered in this village since 2011. Since then, God opened the doors for us to do a biweekly meal program where the gospel was shared with 150 elderly people during their annual hunger season when their maize supply has run out and they are waiting for their next harvest. During this season, many families only eat two meals a week.

We are excited about our new partnership with Family Hope International (FHI) and how God will meet the needs of the most vulnerable and needy. Thank you for all your love and support! Please join us for dinner and an impactful evening: Night of Hope, Sunday, August 17, 6-8pm in the Gym.
