We work for an organization that uses videos to reach Muslims in northern Africa. It's been a busy year since we last gave you an update. Here's what we've been up to:

- Completed three film production trips into North Africa and the Horn;
- · Secured an office space and housing at our base in Italy;
- · Released the short film Using What I've Got, and two additional non-branded videos;

- · Launched a stock video website which provides an authentic identity in the 12 nations we serve;
- · Conducted 12 testimony interviews of believers from a Muslim background.
