- 1. Sunday Morning Elementary Ministry

 - II. During service, oversee Sunday ministry operations on a regular basis and serve as a point person to volunteers and parents

- III. Welcome and partner with families of elementary age children
- IV. Support planning and coordination of programs for Sunday morning ministry including registration, shopping, set up and clean up
- V. Organization of kid's ministry materials (e.g. books, toys, curriculum materials, etc.)

 - II. Assist and support ministry moments beyond weekly duties as time allows (Baptisms, connecting with other kids ministries, etc.)
