

Ministry Residency | College

Description:

The Restoration Ministry Residency is designed to give recent college graduates practical, hands-on ministry experience, while at the same time creating value for Restoration Church Bryan as a whole. Through this opportunity, Restoration's residents will commit to deepening their walk with Christ, growing in theological and biblical understanding, helping in their area of ministry, and engaging in life-on-life discipleship with other growing believers within the church. Ultimately, this residency position is not designed as an on-ramp to becoming a full-time Restoration staff member, but rather to spur on and launch each resident wherever the Lord leads them next.

Roles and Responsibilities:

College Ministry:

- College Team Meetings
 - Regularly meet with the college team to strategize how to best serve the college ministry.
- College MCG Leader Coach
 - Help equip, coach, and shepherd the College MCG leaders.
- College Leader Retreats and meetings
 - Help plan and lead the MCG leader retreats (fall and spring) and monthly meetings.
- Ezer/ Sojourn Events
 - Assist in planning and executing these events each semester, while creating and working alongside a college team.
- College Worship

- Assist in planning, promoting and executing this event each semester. This will involve working with the Worship Team and possibly teaching at the event.
- Summer College MCG
 - Assist in organizing and building the summer college MCGs.
- Spring Retreat
 - Help plan and execute the Spring Retreat for the ministry.
- Self Start
 - Residents are expected to be self starters who are looking to help further the mission and ministry under the guidance and supervision of the College Ministers.

Theological and Biblical Education:

- Meet with Matt and other Ministry Residents once per week to cover an aspect of Biblical and theological education.
- Topics included:
 - Matthew & Gospels Overview
 - Acts
 - Major Bible Doctrine
 - o Pentateuch
- In addition to the classroom setting, residents will be required to complete a project or assignment as a supplement to each Bible/ Theology unit covered such as:
 - Bible Charting
 - Practical & Ministerial Response Paper
 - Reflection Question Responses
- Perspectives
 - If you haven't already completed the course at the certificate level, anticipate taking this course.
- Commit to and complete a Bible in a year reading plan during your time as a resident.

Other:

- Residents will work alongside the college team, reporting to Ben Chubb (College Minister).
- Residents will have regular meetings with Matt Ullrich in order to check-in and provide mutual feedback regarding the residency.
- Residents will be expected to use Google Workspace and keep their google calendar up to date as being an active participant of the Restoration staff family.

Important Details:

Application Process:

- Apply: October 1st December 31st
- Interviews: January 15th-February 15th
- Offers & Acceptance: February 15th-28th
- Support Raising Training: April 19th-20th in College Station, TX

Residency Length:

- 11 months beginning Monday, July 15th
 - The residency program will take place over the course of 10 months (mid-July to mid-May). After mid-May, college residents will have a final month to attend a mission trip and begin a transition process wherever the Lord leads.

Typical Restoration Staff Schedule:

- 40+ hours per week
- 5-8+ hours on Sunday
- 30+ hours Monday–Thursday
 - Typical office hours are 8am-5pm.
- Including various events and/or trips throughout the year

Vacation and Holidays:

- Residents will be given 10 days of personal time off.
 - o 6 of the ten days may be used on a Sunday.

Salary, Fees, & Support:

- **Ministry Residents will be employees of Reliant Mission, succumbed to Restoration Church Bryan, needing to support raise.**
 - Ministry Residents will make a salary of \$2,850/ month.
 - Restoration Ministry Residency Program Fee: \$1,500
 - This covers education, books, materials, retreats, etc.
 - Reliant will have additional fees.
 - The residency cannot begin until the residents are at least 65% funded.
