France

May 15th-23rd, 2026

This trip to Strasbourg, France is primarily focused around giving Restoration members the opportunity to serve our brothers and sisters in France. While there, we will serve the church by hosting outreach events, service projects around the coffee shop, and join along side the language and refugee ministry that is taking place. As with every trip, we seek to be faithful, encouraging Gospel partners for the long term team there.

Cultural Norms & Expectations

Église de la Gare (translation: Church of the Station) is a church that Restoration partners with in Strasbourg, France. Their mission is to see the gospel spread throughout their community through their church.

One of the ways Église de la Gare does this is through Le Quai 67 (pronounced: La K), a coffee shop/community center that serves multiple functions. Its literal meaning is "Platform 67" given their proximity to the train station and the number of nationalities represented in their neighborhood. Through resources such as free French classes, job training, and more, Église de la Gare has used this ministry to bless their neighborhood and bring others in to know Jesus.

Language

French is the most common and understood. We recommend using Duo Lingo for some language learning in the 1-3 months leading up to our departure.

Below are some phrases that you can expect to hear and use:

- Bonjour! Hello/Good day!
- Bonsoir! Good evening!
- Salut! Hi! (Informal)
- Au revoir! Goodbye!
- S'il vous plaît Please (formal)
- Merci Thank you
- Merci beaucoup Thank you very much
- Pardon Pardon me / Excuse me
- Oui Yes
- Non No
- Je ne comprends pas I don't understand
- Parlez-vous anglais ? Do you speak English?
- Je ne parle pas français I don't speak French

Luggage

Everyone will get two bags to bring on the plane. Any combination of below:

- x1 checked bag (Checked bags must be less than 50lbs)
- x1 carry-on
- x1 personal item (i.e. backpack. Must fit under the seat below)

Carry on + personal item must be less than 25lbs. The recommendation is to at least pack one pair of extra clothing in your carry-on as it is common for luggage to get delayed/lost in transit to Japan.

Packing List

- **Do not bring anything you are worried about getting dirty, dusty, broken, or lost**
 - Work clothes (Shorts are not commonly worn. Pack Jeans or dresses. Shorts only able to be worn on hikes)
 - Bible & notebook with pen
 - Water bottle
 - Camera (again, don't bring anything you're worried about losing)
 - Electrical Converter (specifically for France, Type E)
 - Hat
 - Backpack
 - Clothes
 - PJs
 - Rain gear
 - Light jacket
 - COMFORTABLE shoes for walking long distances
 - Toiletries
 - Towel
