It all starts when we realize our own way only leads to death so we repent and confess your name, embracing our forgiveness in you that we might be filled with your Spirit and become your witnesses to this world. 16	<i>"They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer" -Acts 2:42</i>	Lord, the early church devoted itself to you in various ways, not in efforts to merely please you but to get to know you increasingly. Our understanding of you fundamentally changes our brains and our thinking that we might live in light of who you are. Bless our pursuits by giving us more and more of you. Amen.
17	<i>"Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name given under heaven by which we must be saved" -Acts 4:12</i>	Lord, following you is not a choice we have to make. Salvation is found in no one or nothing else. We are saved by you and your name alone. It is in your name we move, live and have our being. Amen.
18	<i>"While they were stoning him, Stephen prayed, 'Lord Jesus, receive my spirit'" -Acts 7:59</i>	Lord, even in the worst of persecutions, you work out all things for the good of the Kingdom. In whatever we may face today, help us to trust in you, knowing that suffering produces many things that we cannot fathom. We give all things, even our suffering, to you. In your name we pray, amen.
19	<i>"Then Peter began to speak: 'I now realize how true it is that God does not show favoritism'" -Acts 10:34</i>	Lord, your good news is not merely for your people but for the whole world. You so loved the world that you gave your one and only Son. Remind us of this truth when we interact with others today. Amen.
20	<i>"When they heard this, they had no further objections and praised God, saying, 'So then, even to Gentiles God has granted repentance that leads to life'" -Acts 11:18</i>	Lord, life is granted to all who would repent and turn to you. Bring to mind people this day who need to know that you love them and you desire to give them life. Use us, Lord, to bear witness to you. Amen.
