Date	Scripture	Prayer
11/3	<i>"Hide not your face from me. Turn not your servant away in anger, O you who have been my help. Cast me not off; forsake me not, O God of my salvation!" -Psalm 27:9</i>	Lord, we have not been cast off by you. In fact, you've moved heaven and earth just to be with us. You are faithful, you are our salvation. Today, and everyday, we praise your name! Amen.
4	<i>"Why are you cast down, O my soul, and why are you in turmoil within me? Hope in God; for I shall again praise him, my salvation." -Psalm 42:5</i>	Lord, often we forget where our hope comes from. It is not from the things of this world, it is from you alone. Why should our souls be cast down? Why should we be filled with turmoil? Our hope is in you, our salvation! Amen.
5	<i>"Cast your burden on the Lord, and he will sustain you; he will never permit the righteous to be moved." -Psalm 55:22</i>	Lord, on you we cast whatever we carry today that is not meant for us to carry. We trust you with our burdens. Amen.
6	<i>"Do not cast me off in the time of old age; forsake me not when my strength is spent." -Psalm 60:8</i>	Lord, we are not valued because of what we are able to do, our abilities, talents, or tasks. We are valued because we are yours, created in your image and likeness. Remind us that our value is not in the things we think of, but in what you say about us, your Beloved. Amen.
7	<i>"...a time to seek, and a time to lose; a time to keep, and a time to cast away." -Ecclesiastes 3:6</i>	Lord, there are things in our lives that we need to distance ourselves from. There are things we need to cast far away from us. As we pray this prayer, those things are coming to mind. Give us the strength and fortitude to cast away that which is not of you. In your name we ask this, amen.
8	<i>"In that day mankind will cast away their idols of silver and their idols of gold, which they made for themselves to worship..." -Isaiah 2:20</i>	Lord, we are guilty of choosing to worship idols, ideals, that which is of this world and will not satisfy. We confess our sinfulness to you, trusting in your grace and mercy for forgiveness. May we cast away these idols and embrace you. Amen.
9	<i>"On that day many will say to me, 'Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in your name, and cast out demons in your name, and do many mighty works in your name?' And then will I declare to them, 'I never knew you; depart from me, you workers of lawlessness.' -Matthew 7:22-23</i>	Lord, these verses are challenging for us. We think that we can objectively look at our lives (or the lives of others) and judge whether we are faithful or not. We may point to the things we've done, but you say that there are some who will do great things for the Kingdom, but who never knew you. Help these words to humble us and cause us to seek after you and you alone. Amen.

Date	Scripture	Prayer
10	<i>"It would be better for him if a millstone were hung around his neck and he were cast not the sea than that he should cause one of these little ones to sin." -Luke 17:2</i>	Lord, forgive us the times our sinfulness causes others to stumble. May we consider the ways in which we model thought and action that is not of you and repent of those things. Amen.
11	<i>"All that the Father gives me will come to me, and whoever comes to me I will never cast out." -John 6:37</i>	Lord, remind us, for ourselves and how we think of others, that you say that WHOEVER comes to you, you will never cast out. So often we try to judge and decide who is not coming to you, who is not worthy of you, who is repulsive to you, but you say, the only requirement is that they come to you. Help us remember that this is the mercy you extended to us that we might extend it to others. Amen.
12	<i>"The night is far gone; the day is at hand. So then let us cast off the works of darkness and put on the armor of light." -Romans 13:12</i>	Lord, our brother Paul reminds us that in light of your Kingdom, in light of you being our King, we must take seriously casting off the works of darkness in our life and putting on the armor of light. Help us Lord, we cannot do this without your transforming Spirit. Amen.
13	<i>"Cast all your anxieties on him, because he cares for you." -1 Peter 2:4</i>	Lord, in this world we have fear, we have anxiety, we have worry. Teach us to cast our anxieties on you, knowing that you care for us. Remind us of who you are and your place in this world and the one to come. Amen.
14	<i>"There is no fear in love, but perfect love casts out fear. For fear has to do with punishment, and whoever fears has not been perfected in love." -1 John 4:18</i>	Lord, sometimes your word can be confusing. We are told that fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom, and yet also told that there is no fear in love. Lord, help us to hold these things in tension, recognizing that fear of the Lord is awe, reverence, a taking in of all that you are. The fear our brother John talks about is something else, not rooted in love or reverence, but fear as one would have for a dictator. May we come to you when we are confused about your Word, trusting your Spirit to illuminate it for us. Amen.
15	<i>"The twenty-four elders fall down before him who is seated on the throne and worship him who lives forever and ever. They cast their crowns before the throne..." -Revelation 4:10</i>	Lord, in this world we may have positions, power or authority, but in light of you that is all worthless. In the end whatever we gain in this world in these respects will be cast down in front of you. Our whole hearts desire is kneel at your throne. Amen.
16	<i>"Master, we saw someone casting out demons in your name, and we tried to stop him, because he does not follow with us." -Luke 9:49</i>	Lord, often we, in the church, can find ourselves evaluating others, judging them, seeking to correct things we disagree with. Remind us of our place. Of course we can lovingly come alongside a brother or sister and encourage them toward what we see as faithfulness, but help us not to get prideful in these endeavors, assuming we are always correct in all we think and believe. Humble us Lord. Amen.
17	<i>"And he went throughout all Galilee, preaching in their synagogues and casting out demons." -Mark 1:39</i>	Lord, remind us regularly that we are in a spiritual war. Our enemies are not the flesh and blood people we interact with every day, it is evil itself. They have no power over us in Christ Jesus. Remind us of this truth daily. Amen.

18	<i>"And when they had crucified him, they divided his garments among them by casting lots." -Matthew 27:35</i>	Lord, what you saw as you hung on that cross... the soldiers casting lots for your clothing, worried about the things of this world and missing what was going on right in front of them. And yet you prayed for the, "Forgive them Father for they know not what they do." How beautiful and patient is your love for us. Amen.
19	<i>"Passing alongside the Sea of Galilee, he saw Simon and Andrew the brother of Simon casting a net into the sea, for they were fishermen." -Mark 1:16</i>	Lord, we love that you meet us right where we are. Some of us are far from you, living completely apart from you. Some of us have been walking with you closely for many years. Regardless, we are all people in process, being transformed by your Spirit. Thank you for meeting us where we are. Amen.
20	<i>"And whoever does not fall down and worship shall immediately be cast into a burning fiery furnace." -Daniel 3:6</i>	Lord, this world has a way of thinking that challenges us daily to kneel at its alter. Help us to see all things through Kingdom-lenses that we might be able to honor you in all that we do daily. Keep us from evil, Lord. Amen.
21	<i>"O you who turn justice to wormwood and cast down righteousness to the earth!" -Amos 5:7</i>	Lord, when we believe we know what is best, what is right, and we do not defer to you, we sin like our first parents. We prop up our definition of justice or righteousness which is but a shadow, a mockery of true justice and righteousness that comes from you. Humble us, Lord. Humble us. Amen.
22	<i>"He will again have compassion on us; he will tread our iniquities underfoot. You will cast all your sins into the depths of the sea." -Micah 7:19</i>	Lord, these verses that declare boldly that you WILL have compassion on us, that you WILL tread our iniquities underfoot and that you WILL cast all our sins into the depths of the sea, they are great hopes for us. We can trust these words because you are trustworthy! Praise be to you! Amen.
23	<i>"Cast away from you all the transgressions that you have committed, and make yourselves a new heart and a new spirit! Why will you die, O house of Israel?" Ezekiel 18:31</i>	Lord, your people were told to cast away their transgressions and make for themselves a new heart, but they were unable... we are unable. You then promise that you will do that- you will cast away our transgressions and you will create in us a new heart! Thank you, Lord Jesus! You do that which we cannot do for ourselves! Praise your Name! Amen.
24	<i>"And I said to them, "Cast away the detestable things your eyes feast on, every one of you, and do not defile yourselves with the idols of Egypt; I am the Lord your God." -Ezekiel 20:7</i>	Lord, help us to see the things of this world like you see them. May we not choose to chase after the things of this world, but look to you and you alone. Amen.
25	<i>"...they have cast their gods into the fire. For they were no gods, but the work of men's hands, wood and stone. There fore they were destroyed." -Isaiah 37:9</i>	Lord, help us to see our idols for what they are, false gods, not gods at all. Let us then treat them accordingly. They are worthless, meaningless. Our hope is only in you. Amen.
26	<i>"For he has humbled the inhabitants of the height, the lofty city. He lays it low, lays it low to the ground, casts it to the dust." -Isaiah 26:5</i>	Lord, may we not hold onto our positions in this world as though they are anything to boast about. May we not be proud, but ever be seeking after you. Amen.

27	<i>"God has cast me into the mire, and I have become like dust and ashes."</i> <i>-Job 30:19</i>	Lord, at times it can feel like our lives are just one travesty after another. We can lose sight of who you are and begin to judge you and your character based on our circumstances. Remind us, Lord, that regardless of what we face in this world, you are unchanging, you are good. Amen.
28	<i>"And you, Solomon my son, know the God of your father and serve him with a whole heart and with a willing mind, for the Lord searches all hearts and understands every plan and thought. If you seek him, he will be found by you, but if you forsake him, he will cast you off forever."</i> <i>-1 Chronicles 28:9</i>	Lord, if we seek you, we will find you. Help us this day and every day to seek after you and you alone. Amen.
29	<i>"Do not turn to idols or make for yourselves gods of cast metal: I am the Lord your God."</i> <i>Leviticus 19:4</i>	Lord, help us not to create idols that we think will satisfy, made with our own hands. You are our God. It is in you that we place our trust, our hope, our lives. Amen.
