This person will capture video and photos during Sunday services and church events, edit and produce engaging content, and develop a volunteer media team to serve alongside them. The goal is to creatively share what God is doing in and through our church in ways that inspire, invite, and connect with people both inside and outside the church.

- Edit photos and video content for use on social media, website, and in-service presentations.
- Create highlight reels, testimony videos, and recap content as needed.
- Build, train, and lead a volunteer media team to assist with photography, videography, and production.
- Ensure all media aligns with the church's mission, values, and branding.
- Collaborate with pastoral and communications staff to plan upcoming media needs.
- Organize and archive media files for easy access and future use.
