CODE OF CONDUCT FOR CAMP MARANATHA 2025

Camp Maranatha is a Christian camp and operates in accordance with the 2022-2026 IPHC Manual. We strive to maintain a spiritual atmosphere. You will have a great time at camp if you will follow this code of conduct. Please review this information. Failure to comply with this code could result in dismissal from camp.

- The Appalachian DM Council will use the 2022-2026 IPHC Manual & IPHC Position Paper (Marriage and Sexual Morality) regarding matters of sexuality for campers and staff.
- Follow all instructions from the camp staff.
- Follow the camp schedule.
- Always stay within the camp boundaries.
- You must check out before leaving camp.
- Stay safe and keep others safe. This means no horseplay.
- Bring and wear only modest clothes. (Shorts for females and males are to be <u>at least "mid-thigh"</u> to the tip of middle finger when arm extended by side. (NO gym shorts, NO spandex shorts, NO cheerleading shorts & NO short shorts if shorts do not meet guidelines you will be asked to change or will be sent home.) No crop top, off shoulder, spaghetti strap or fishnet shirts, no gothic style clothing and no clothing that advertises alcohol, tobacco, or secular music. Girls: no 2-piece bathing suits)
- Cover (clothing) must be worn to and from the pool and restroom, male and female. Shoes must be worn.
- All medications must be in <u>original package</u> and turned in at registration to the camp nurse.
- Electronics such as iPods, Cell phones, I-Watches, etc., are not permitted.
- Treat camp facilities and equipment with care. Any intentional damage will incur a charge to the camper.
- No food or drink allowed upstairs in the dorm or Bunkhouse.
- No physical display of affection allowed.
- Report any abuse (physical, verbal, sexual) immediately to the camp director.
- NO Bullying
- Keep hands off others property.
- The use of tobacco, drugs, vaping devices or alcohol is prohibited.
- Only emergency phone calls permitted with the director's permission. No cell phones permitted.
- Closed Campus VISITORS by request or invitation only.
- Weapon, Drug, Alcohol and Vaping Free Zone: Camp Director reserves the right to inspect camper luggage (for cause).
