What you need:

- Enjoy being around children
- Willing to follow directions and anticipate the needs of the teacher to best serve the students

Duties:

- · Attend orientation meetings and bi-annual trainings (Spring and Fall)
- Respond to scheduling emails in a timely fashion and entering blackout dates when possible
- Be on time and attend Sunday Morning Huddle at 8:10 AM or 10:10 AM on the Sundays you serve
- Come and grab your class' clipboard at the GA desk clipboard (8:45 AM or 10:45 AM)
- Mark children on roster as they enter the classroom with one mark showing they are present
 paying attention to kids on the roster who are not in class or kids who come in but who do not have a name tag
- Match code on security pick-up ticket to student's nametag before releasing a child— mark each kid off with a second mark on the clipboard as they leave with their adult (there should be two marks on each nametag at the end of the morning)
- Participate in activities and lessons (set a good example and model good behavior)
- Try to anticipate what pilots and students may need assistance with throughout the morning
- Help teacher clean up after class is over
- * If you would like to try leading before entering a Pilot role, lead opening Verse/Big Picture Question and encourage the children's participation

Expectations:

- Be a good role model

 have a cheerful attitude & follow directions well
- Allow the children to answer the questions
- Encourage the children
- Keep phones in pockets and out of sight. Cell phones should not be used while serving.
- If you cannot make your scheduled date, let Chelsea Hoffman know as quickly as possible (for advanced schedule conflicts, use the Grace App to block out the dates you're unable to serve)
