**What did the wind and waves do after Jesus spoke to them?** *(The wind stopped blowing, and the waves stopped crashing.)*

***Why did Jesus perform miracles? Jesus performed miracles to show He is the Son of God***

**Gospel Gems:**

Jesus and the disciples were in a boat during a storm.

Jesus told the wind and waves to be still.

Jesus showed His friends that He is the Lord.

**February 8<sup>th</sup>**  
**Jesus Fed a Crowd**



Jesus' disciples had been healing people and teaching them. They were working so hard, they did not even have time to eat! So Jesus said, "Let's go to a quiet place and rest."



A crowd of people followed them, and Jesus taught the crowd about God and his Kingdom. It was late and the disciples came to Jesus and said, “Tell the people to go get something to eat.” But Jesus said, “You give them something to eat.”



“We can’t feed this many people!” they said. “It would cost a lot of money.”

“How many loaves of bread do you have?” Jesus asked. A boy from the crowd brought five loaves of bread and two fish to Jesus, but it wasn’t enough. But Jesus told the disciples to tell everyone to sit down.



Jesus took the five loaves of bread and two fish. He looked up to heaven, and then He blessed the bread. Then the disciples gave the food to all the people and everyone ate until full.

**How many people did Jesus feed?** *(more than 5,000)*

***Why did Jesus perform miracles? Jesus performed miracles to show He is the Son of God***

Jesus loved people and healed them.

Jesus fed a crowd with five loaves and two fish.

Jesus provides for people.

**February 15<sup>th</sup>**

**Jesus Walked on Water**

**Jesus Showed His Glory**




Jesus went up on a high mountain with Peter, James, and John. The disciples fell asleep, and Jesus prayed. All of a sudden, Jesus changed.
