A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Church Family,

Johnny Blaise gave me an awesome coffee mug that reads, "I can do all things through a verse taken out of context." Satire is Johnny's middle name. For reference, the coffee mug is about Philippians 4:13, which reads, "I can do all things through him who strengthens me." That verse has been butchered at times by taking it out of context and using it for selfish ends—like

getting the date, making the deal, or scoring the touchdown.

The verse is actually about how Paul has learned the secret to be content in every circumstance, whether well-fed or hungry, in plenty or in want—he can do all things through Christ who gives him strength to be content regardless of the situation.



Contentment doesn't come easy for most because, as Bruce Springsteen sang, "Everybody's got a hungry heart." We all have a desire for more than we have or simply a deep-seated yearning for a different life. No great thing in this world can ever satisfy our longing hearts.

Lewis uses the word, "Sehnsucht," which is a German word for a deep, unexplainable longing for something that may not even exist in our current reality. He says that our longings are "only the scent of a flower we have not found, the echo of a tune we have not heard, news from a country we have never visited." We all have a sense of yearning for something beautiful, perfect, and ultimately, unattainable in this world. Of course all longings, as Lewis argues, find their end in God—only in Him will our longings be satisfied; only in Him will we be content. He's the telos for which all longings find their consummated end.

I want to challenge you to be content. Know God and enjoy him forever. Keep pressing on.



MFUGE Camp (Mission Fuge): June 9-14




Our student ministry attended MFuge Camp this summer at North Greenville University, and was an incredible experience.



DNOW WEEKEND

Exile shows up all over the Bible–from Adam and Eve leaving the garden, to Israel's captivity in Babylon, to Jesus stepping into our broken world. Being an exile means feeling far from home, far from comfort, and sometimes even far from God. But here's the truth: even in the middle of the mess, God never leaves His people. Exile isn't the end–it's the place where God shapes us, builds hope, and reminds us that our true home is with Him. This year for DNOW we will be walking through 1 Peter diving into the theme of being Exiles.

DNOW stands for "Disciple Now" weekend. This is a time when students join our church family to learn about Jesus for the first time or to grow in His image. Students will enjoy food, offsite recreation events, music, and more, but even more importantly, this weekend allows time for students to focus on Christ as they begin the school year.

This year's DNOW will be held at FBC Enterprise. We will be at the church during the day, recreation tracks in the afternoon, and then students will go home and sleep in their own beds at night. We believe this format is the best of both worlds: rested students having fun and growing in their knowledge of Christ. 
