# A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Church Family,

The Protestant Reformation is a history lesson we need be reminded of today. In the 16th century, Martin Luther challenged the corruption of the established church. He called her back to the authority of Scripture and reminded the world that salvation is by grace alone through faith alone in Christ alone. His bold stand reshaped the church and the world, anchoring believers to the truth of God's Word over the traditions of man.

It was not merely a movement of protest but a recovery of the gospel itself, setting a precedent that the church must always be willing to examine herself in light of Scripture and be reformed by it.

That same call is still needed today. The church is never beyond the danger of drifting into empty ritual, worldliness, or compromise. The

Reformers gave us the phrase *ecclesia semper reformanda*—"the church always reforming." This does not mean constant change for novelty's sake, but rather a humble readiness to be corrected, sharpened, and revived by God's Word and Spirit. We must always align our faith, doctrine, and practice with Scripture so that Christ remains at the center of all we believe and do.

To remember and celebrate the Reformation, we are going to have a special guest on October 26 (Reformation Sunday) - Dr. Dustin Bruce, Dean of Boyce College and Professor of Christian Theology and Church History at Southern Seminary. Dr. Bruce will preach a sermon in the morning and give a lecture that evening. The lecture will include an overview study of church history from the dawn of the Reformation to today. He will also unpack elements like what led to the Protestant Reformation, how the Roman Catholic Church reacted, why various Protestant denominations formed, and what theological and cultural developments have led the Church to where we are today. I hope you're able to join us for this rich and insightful day.
