 - b. **Disciplemakers Cohort** A group that gathers once a month for 6-12 months to grow in disciplemakeing. It would involved a different training topic each time along with a check in and prayer.
 - c. Worship Vision Team Jeremy and Peter have been talking a lot about giving more attention and focus over the next year to our modern worship service. In January we will have a Worship Vision morning with key stakeholders followed by a team that follows up on goals and direction from that meeting.
 - 1. Peter and Jeremy will share more about this during December's board meeting. This team will build a vision, unity and engagement in the Worship ministry.
 - d. **Aspiring Shepherds Group.** 1 Timothy 3:1 says: "If someone aspires to be an elder, he desires an honorable position." We will meet 2-4 times after the first of the year with those who we are wanting to consider serving on the Shepherding Board. We will spend time talking through a biblical picture of church leadership and answering their questions about this role.
