The song "Jesus Freak" was all about being on fire for Jesus and not ashamed of it. I loved that song. I loved the music and I loved the message. It encouraged me to be my own, on-fire version of a "Jesus Freak."

Now, fast-forward some 30 years, and I still love the song and its message. But a lot has changed since then. Toby Mac has a more recent hit I like called "Faithfully," in which he sings the lyric "It's been a hard year it almost took me down." And life, even (or especially) in ministry, is hard.

When I returned to Grand Lake from Cincinnati I shared the more recent Toby Mac song with you my first Sunday back. Suffice it to say that after seasons of Covid and disaffiliation, it's been some hard years. And yes, if I'm honest, they almost took me down. I'm grateful that they didn't; but I'm ever more aware of how close I came to being "taken down." I'm also much more aware of my need to focus on my own spiritual, emotional, mental and physical health so I don't get taken down in the future.

For this reason, I will be taking Renewal Leave from July 28 through September 9th. I will use this time to rest, study and recharge my spiritual batteries. The objective is to rekindle my spiritual fire and regain that true "Jesus Freak" love and commitment. This will not only be good for me, but also for the church. You deserve a pastor that is fresh, healthy and on fire for Jesus and the mission he's given us. I'm approaching Renewal Leave kind of like the safety briefing on an airplane. I'm putting on my own oxygen mask so I'll be better able to help others.
