Advent Sermon Series

Advent begins the 4th Sunday before Christmas, and this year December 3 begins our new Christian year. Our focus will be "Christmas Is Not Your Birthday." I will be using a variety of resources you may have or may want to borrow from the church library. They are *Christmas Is Not Your Birthday* by Mike Slaughter, *Enough* by Adam Hamilton, *25 Days, 26 Ways to Make This your Best Christmas Ever* by Ace Collins, and I will give mention to the parody surrounding false expectations we've built around the perfect Christmas celebration found in the movie "*Christmas Vacation*" starring Chevy Chase and Beverly DeAngelo.

Join me each week in learning more about how our traditions of Christmas have shifted and changed, and how our understanding as Christians is not what our secular world prescribes. Maybe this year we can all begin the shift towards giving as much to those in need as we give to the rest of our friends and families on our gift lists.

January Sermon Series

As we begin a New Year, our Christian calendar is still celebrating Jesus' birth. On January 7, we will celebrate Epiphany. This is the time between Christmas and Lent. It marks the coming of the wise men, the first non-Jewish people to worship the Son of God and remember the time God was made known to us and the world.

Week 2, we will celebrate the Baptism of our Lord, which reminds all Christians of their baptism. As a congregation, we will reaffirm our Baptismal Covenant to remember our baptism and be thankful.

Week 3, we will recall some of the Old Testament favorites of how God worked in the lives of Moses, Daniel, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego found in Exodus and Daniel 3 & 6.

Week 4, I invite you to read Samuel 3: 1-20 and John 1: 43-51 before Worship, as we learn how Jesus is calling us today.





What is a Community Group?

G - Guided by a Leader:

Every community group needs a leader. The leader is a capable, qualified Grand Lake member/regular attendee who assumes spiritual responsibility for this community group of people. He/She/they agree to love and invest in these people and strive to lead them to grow closer to God and to be in relationship with one another.

R - Regular meeting times, preferably weekly:

The goal is to meet frequently enough for friendships to form and to be able to recognize when someone is not connected or struggling.

O - Open God's Word:

When groups meet, time is set aside to explore and discuss God's Word together. The Bible is always the central driving force behind everything we do. The focus in a community group is to talk about God's Word together in a way that helps us to be more obedient so that we will be "doers" of the Word and not "hearers" only. (James 1:22)

U – United in Love:

The goal is to not only grow closer to God but also to each other in order to reach COMMUNITY – authentically being a part of each other's lives – throughout the week and not just during the meetings. A healthy community group is bound by a "Community Group Covenant."

P - Pray for one another:

Time will always be set aside where we can genuinely share what's going on in our lives and authentically pray for one another.

If you have been thinking about being in a Bible study, please pray about joining one of these groups.


