

Hey guys!! I am SO excited that all of you are allowing your kids to go to Kids456! I can promise that they are going to have a fantastic time, and they will come home so much closer to God!

I hope that this information will answer any questions that you have about camp, but if not, please feel free to call, text, or email me anytime!!

- On Wednesday, February 11th, we will be doing lice checks before the kids go to their Wednesday night class. Please make sure that we check each of your children to save time on the day that we leave.
- We will be meeting at the church at 12:40 on Friday, February 13th, and we will leave at 1:00.
- The concession stand will be open each day of camp, if you would like to send snack money for your child. The items at the concession stand range from \$.50-\$2.50. Please send it in two envelopes or plastic bags labeled with your child's name (one for each day). We will collect the money from you before we leave for camp on Friday, and we will pass them out to the kids before we have time in the rec hall each day.
- Kids456 will also be selling camp shirts for \$20, if you would like to send extra money for a shirt. Please send t-shirt money in an envelope that has their name and "T-shirt money," as well.
- We will have a Glow Night on Friday in the rec hall, so the kids are welcome to bring fun, glow in the dark clothes. Glow clothes are totally optional!
- We will return to the church on Sunday afternoon. We will send a text to let you know as soon as we are leaving Springville, but we should arrive shortly before the second service ends.

- Lastly, I have provided a quick checklist of things to remember to pack for camp. If you are like me, I am a list person, so seeing the little things typed out helps me to remember them, haha!!

Things to send with your child to *Kids 456*:

- Sleep wear
- Toiletries (soap, shampoo, toothpaste, deodorant, etc.)
- Twin size sheets or sleeping bag
- Twin size blanket
- Towels, wash clothes, and shower shoes
- Umbrella/rain coat (optional)
- Bible (they are often lost, so please no keepsake Bibles)
- Medications, if applicable (Please bring these in a labeled bag with the prescribing instructions.)
- Casual dress clothes

- Play clothes and shoes
- Money for concessions and T-shirts
- Jacket/sweatshirt

And remember, kids lose stuff at camp. There is no way to prevent it. Be careful what you let them bring. Please do not send your child with a cell phone, as they are easily stolen. If they need to contact you or if you need to contact them, you can contact Tabitha or Gabi. Our cell phone numbers are available in this packet. Please remember cell phone service is not great at the camp, so we will respond as soon as we possibly can!
