FINANCIAL DETAILS:

The cost estimate is broken down into two categories:

Construction: \$21,500,000
Soft Costs (Audio, Visual, Lighting, Furnishings, Signage, Landscaping): \$5,500,000

In total: \$27,000,000

This will be paid for through cash on hand (\$3,000,000), giving campaign (\$12-\$22 million), and balance through 15 year loan paid by the budget.

Growing a Legacy PHASE I AND II HISTORY

As we look ahead with great anticipation for all that God will do through Phase III of Growing A Legacy, it's important to pause and reflect on the faithfulness He has already shown through the first two phases of this journey. Each step has been marked by prayer, sacrifice, and a desire to create space for people to encounter Christ and grow in community.

PHASE I: In January 2005, Fellowship launched Phase I of the campaign with the goal of establishing a permanent church home after years of meeting at the University School of Jackson. This phase included the construction of our original Worship Center and the two-story Learning Center, which provided classroom space for infants, toddlers, and our K–6th grade theme rooms designed to make learning about Jesus engaging and memorable. In June of 2005 Fellowship approved a master site plain which included the Phase 3 structures.

PHASE II: Building on that foundation, Phase II launched in April 2014 and focused on creating more space for growing families and ministry needs. This included the construction of the two-story Family Ministry Building—featuring our multi-use Chapel space, Student Ministries spaces including the indoor/outdoor café, and classrooms. This phase also expanded our impact beyond our walls, providing funds to launch our South Campus in 2017 and helping to build a school and support education sponsorships for children in Williamson, Haiti.

A message from our Lead Pastor **EUGENE BRANDT**



Dear Fellowship Family,

In the spring of 2001, a small group of believers felt a calling—to plant a church in Jackson that would be defined by compelling relationships with God and others that have an irresistible influence in our world. Inspired by the ministry of Fellowship Bible Church in Little Rock, they envisioned a community rooted in Scripture, vibrant in worship, and intentional in discipleship. From those humble beginnings, God has grown our church into a thriving family of faith, where lives are transformed, and relationships are deepened.

We are launching the third and final phase of our Giving A Legacy Campaign, based on a master plan created 20 years ago, a multi-year vision to expand our church home in ways that make space for what God is doing among us. In this phase, we're seeking to raise between 12 and 22 million dollars to build a new 1,600 seat worship center, prayer chapel, expanded kids area, indoor playground, café, new multi-purpose meeting rooms and gathering spaces. All in all, these will amount to 59,000 square feet of much needed space. These spaces are not merely buildings; they are environments designed to create encounters with Christ, nurture community, and equip us to serve our city and beyond. As people long to know Christ, we are committed to creating spaces where they can come and fellowship with Him.

Whether you've been part of Fellowship Bible Church for years or are just beginning to call this place home, you are part of something God is building here. We're asking you to prayerfully consider giving not because the church "needs" something, but because people are still longing for hope, belonging, and a deeper relationship with God.

Look for invitations to our advance commitment meetings on August 5th & 7th, with the official campaign launching on August 10th during State of the Church and over the following three weeks. You're also invited to join us for a groundbreaking celebration on Sunday, August 31st, immediately following the last service.

Inside the **SPACE**

WORSHIP CENTER:

There will be a new 1,600 seat theatre style auditorium with fixed seating. This will allow us to return to two services at 9:00 and 10:30 and see more of our church family between services. The existing WC will return to its original name the SEC (Special Events Center) and will be home to FSM's high school meeting space.



ATRIUM: The entrance to the new WC from the Learning Center atrium will be through the existing playground. This will be converted to an atrium with an Indoor playground, cafe, and expanded two story educational space for toddlers/infants (first floor) and Adults (second floor). The outdoor playground will be moving to a new location with updated surfaces.







PRAYER CHAPEL Part of our original master plan from 2005, this 70 seat chapel will be open daily for prayer and meditation. The space will be designed to inspire us to lift our eyes to the heavens and experience the splendor and majesty of our Great Redeemer God!
