## **BACKGROUND:**

Acts 1 shows us that Jesus' ministry continued beyond the Gospels. The ongoing work begun by his life, death, resurrection, and ascension is now carried out through the Holy Spirit. Here, the disciples expect the immediate restoration of the nation of Israel, but Jesus gives them a global mandate. He tells them, "You will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth."

As this pattern unfolds throughout the book of Acts, the movement of the Spirit that began at Pentecost in Acts 2 spreads despite persecution to Judea and Samaria and–through the conversion of Saul–leads to a missionary movement to the nations. The same Spirit still moves today. He calls us as the Church to pray, cross barriers, and go wherever Jesus sends.
