## **Worship Discussion and Reflection Questions**

Series: The Multifaceted Gospel Sermon: A King Forever Scripture: Jeremiah 33:14-22

<sup>14</sup> "Behold, the days are coming, declares the Lord, when I will fulfill the promise I made to the house of Israel and the house of Judah. <sup>15</sup> In those days and at that time I will cause a righteous Branch to spring up for David, and he shall execute justice and righteousness in the land. <sup>16</sup> In those days Judah will be saved, and Jerusalem will dwell securely. And this is the name by which it will be called: 'The Lord is our righteousness.' <sup>17</sup> "For thus says the Lord: David shall never lack a man to sit on the throne of the house of Israel, <sup>18</sup> and the Levitical priests shall never lack a man in my presence to offer burnt offerings, to burn grain offerings, and to make sacrifices forever." <sup>19</sup> The word of the Lord came to Jeremiah: <sup>20</sup> "Thus says the Lord: If you can break my covenant with the day and my covenant with the night, so that day and night will not come at their appointed time, <sup>21</sup> then also my covenant with David my servant may be broken, so that he shall not have a son to reign on his throne, and my covenant with the Levitical priests my ministers. <sup>22</sup> As the host of heaven cannot be numbered and the sands of the sea cannot be measured, so I will multiply the offspring of David my servant, and the Levitical priests who minister to me."

## **Reflection Questions:**

- When are times when you are likely to question God's faithfulness? What situations in your life cause you to wonder if Jesus really is King?
- What are some ways you long for King Jesus to execute righteousness? What brokenness and injustice do you see that you wish for God to make right?
- Why is it an afront to God for us to try to earn our salvation? In what ways does that diminish the gift we have in Christ's sacrifice?
- What is one area of your life you can entrust to God's faithfulness? How can you trust Him to be King of your life?

## **Guided Prayer:**

Praise Jesus for being the King long predicted. Praise Him for His righteous ways. Praise Him for the great sacrifice He made for you on the cross. Praise Him for His faithfulness to you, as sure as day and night. Repent of the ways you do not trust Him. Ask Him to help you to know He is truly faithful. Praise Him again for His great faithfulness to you. In Jesus' name, Amen.
