

## **Worship Discussion and Reflection Questions**

**Sermon:** The WHO of Growth

**Scripture:** I Corinthians 3:5-9

<sup>5</sup> What then is Apollos? What is Paul? Servants through whom you believed, as the Lord assigned to each. <sup>6</sup> I planted, Apollos watered, but God gave the growth. <sup>7</sup> So neither he who plants nor he who waters is anything, but only God who gives the growth. <sup>8</sup> He who plants and he who waters are one, and each will receive his wages according to his labor. <sup>9</sup> For we are God's fellow workers. You are God's field, God's building.

### ***Reflection Questions:***

- Who are the people who have invested in you? How are you investing in others?
- In what ways do I see others as God's gift for my growth?
- Where do I need to pray for God to unify my heart to my church family?
- Where am I clinging to my work instead of God's work? In what ways can you actively turn your attention to Christ?

### ***Guided Prayer:***

Praise God for causing growth in you and in His church (not only Bonhomme, but throughout the world). Thank Him for people who have invested in your spiritual growth. Ask God to unify us, just as He and the Father are one. Repent of any ways that you have taken your focus off of Christ. Ask God to help you turn your eyes back to Him and Him alone. Ask God to give you faith to trust His work. Ask Him to continue His good work of spiritual growth in you, our church, and in His Kingdom. In Jesus' name, Amen.
