PART 25 NO MISUSE! Hallowed Be Thy Name (Exodus 20:7)

INTRODUCTION:

"O LORD, our Lord, **How majestic is Your name** in all the earth,..."

—Psalm 8:1

"...in order that <u>all the peoples of the earth may know Your name</u>, to fear You, as do Your people Israel, and that they may know that this house which I have built is <u>called by Your name</u>."

 - God's Exclusive Claim: He condemns rivals. (20:3)

"You shall have no other gods before Me."

- Man's Endemic Corruption: We create rivals. (Romans 1:18-25)
 - "... they exchanged the truth of God for a lie,..."

—Romans 1:25

- Christ's Emancipating Conquest: He conquers rivals & cleanses rebels. (Heb. 10:12-19)
 - "...Christ had offered for all time a single sacrifice for sins, ..."

—Hebrews 10:12-18

#2 - No Idols! (Exodus 20:4-6)

- Welcome to a world... full of idols, full of ignorance, and full of immorality,... (Acts 17:16f.)
- "You **shall not make for yourself an idol**, or any likeness of what is in heaven above or on the earth beneath or in the water under the earth. ⁵ "**You shall not worship them or serve them**."
- The first command focused on the "<u>Who</u>" of worship. The second command focuses on the "<u>How</u>" of worship.
- God revealed Himself to Israel through an audible voice, not a visible image.
- Idolatry is not just another sin, it is a <u>root</u> sin, a <u>universal</u> sin, a <u>binding</u> sin, and a <u>deceptive</u> sin. (1 Corinthians 10:1-14)
- All sin is social.
