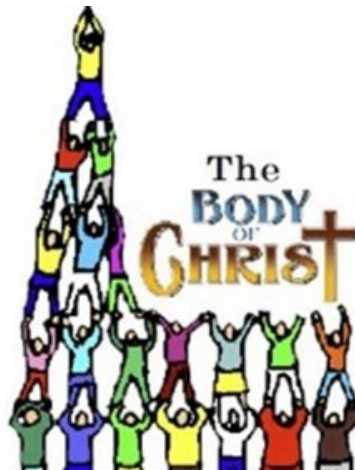

From the Pastor

Now, you are the Body of Christ and individually members of it..... 1 Corinthians 12: 27

As the Easter season comes to a close and we look forward to Pentecost, I want to share one of the many ways we understand resurrection. The topic of resurrection is a mystery for mortal human beings. No one living can speak with certainty about resurrection outside of the context of faith. Many believers throughout the centuries have written about their experience of the presence of Christ in their lives. Many of us have experiences of the love and mercy of Jesus in our lives. None of us know for sure what or

when or how the resurrection will be realized. I have come to embrace deeply Paul's metaphor of "The Body," as the way believers are to manifest the resurrection. Each person of faith is part of the resurrected Jesus in the world. Together we make up the Church. The Church is both temporal and eternal.

As members of the church, each of us is a part of the Body of Christ. The living Christ is present in the world through the actions of His church. Our hands, our eyes, our mouth and ears and feet are the resurrection. When the Holy Spirit fills us with power, we become Jesus in the world.

I want Kernstown United Methodist Church to embrace our identity as the Body of Christ and explore just what part each of us might be in His ministry. This year, each member of our congregation has been identified with one of our four ministry work areas. *(Some people have identified with more than one....)* Please take note of your area and find out how you can serve. If you wish to serve in a different area, reach out to our leaders and let them know. Our body is not complete without all of its parts. We can not function without all of our parts, and all of our parts are made into one body. We can not separate ourselves from each other or from the work of Christ through the church. We are blessed to be part of the Body at Kernstown United Methodist Church which is blessed to be part of the Church Universal.

May the Holy Spirit fill you with power to offer your gifts and graces to the work of the resurrected Jesus.

• **COVID Update:** Per CDC, May 11 marked the end of the federal COVID 19 Public Health Emergency declaration.
• The community transmission is LOW for both Winchester and Frederick County. After May 11th, this will no longer be tracked.

• Vaccines for COVID will continue to remain available and free for adults and children.

• COVID 19 at-home tests may not be covered by insurance.

• Treatments will remain available for free as long as supplies last.

WALK with a DOC - Twice a month on 2nd Wednesday at 11 am & 4th Saturday at 9 am. Meet at Valley Health Wellness & Fitness Center for a talk by a physician & walk around the lake with others at your own pace.

SCRIPTURE: 1 Thessalonians 5:7 NRSV "Pray without ceasing." James 5:16 "Pray for one another that you may be healed." Exodus 15:26 "I am the Lord your healer."

Health Education—The Power of Prayer & Healing: Health means the state achieved when a person's mind, body, and spirit work as God created them to do.

Healthy practices and habits need to be developed and practiced reducing the risk of illnesses and injuries. These healthy practices include prayer, reading the Bible, attending church/worship, seeing your health care provider, healthy nutrition, regular exercise, controlling anger, hand washing, forgiveness, respect of self and others, nonviolence, and love. Studies show that patients that are prayed for (intercessory prayers) experience less complications, do better, heal faster, have less pain, receive less antibiotics and diuretics, have fewer visits to the doctor, and spend less time in the hospital when hospitalized.

Further studies show that people who pray tend to get sick less often, live healthier and longer lives, have lower blood pressure, fewer strokes, fewer heart attacks, and less depression, and when depressed, recover faster.

Studies of prayer have been conducted by Harvard's Dr. Herbert Benson. He states that all forms of prayer evoke a relaxation process that decreases stress, soothes the body, and promotes healing. Prayers of repetition of sound and words cause healing effects as The Lord's Prayer and meditation.
