Pentecost Sunday According to Leviticus 23:15-1, the Hebrews celebrated the Feast of Pentecost for seven consecutive weeks. It began "the morning following the Sabbath day" of Passover. Thus comes its title, the "Feast of Weeks." Later in the Old Testament this feast became known as "Pentecost" ("fiftieth"). Pentecost – according to the Greek language (Acts 2:1; 2 Macc. 12:32), meaning "fiftieth," since it was celebrated on the 50th day from the Feast of First fruits.

Pentecost was originally an agricultural festival celebrating the first harvest of the growing season. Later it became a commemoration of the giving of the land of Canaan to the people of Israel; and then even later, it morphed into an observance of the giving of the law to Moses on Mount Sinai

For Christians it's not simply a birthday commemoration, just a marker along the road, a milestone passed. It is a moment of power that started the work of the church, it is an offering of transformation, and the receiving of the gift of the Holy Spirit.
