Happy New Year!



 medical conditions. She changed her mother's diet, stopped all meds, and began praying and believing God
 for a healing. Just a couple months ago, she reported that after taking her mother to see her doctor, they
 found no sign of diabetes, and both her blood pressure and cholesterol were normal. She refocused her life
 to align with where God was working and He showed up in her favor with an unexplainable healing, except,
 but God!

These are just a few of the testimonies that we've heard about God's grace in action.


2024 Community Workshops


Episcopal Consecration of Bishop Designate Dennis D. Austin Jr.




