Connections Minister

The Southgate Church of Christ in San Angelo, Texas invites qualified candidates for the full-time position of Connections Minister to partner with our church family in fulfilling her mission, *The Great Commission*, and in realizing her vision for experiencing Christ's transforming love. A Connections Minister fulfills the vital and interrelated roles of:

- connecting our members to each other and to our ministries to foster discipleship pathways that edify and equip our members, recent converts, and seekers, and
- administering the day-to-day operations of the church.

In addition to this open Connections Minister position, our current full-time ministry team consists of a Preaching Minister and a Youth Minister. The Preaching Minister is in the pulpit most Sunday mornings, but all ministers are in the pulpit from time to time.

Key Responsibilities:

- Be a visible, authentic presence who demonstrates the transforming love of Jesus Christ to this church and this community. *This is the first priority of our Leadership Team, which consists of all shepherds and full-time ministers.*
- Ensure that all members and ministries are appropriately equipped to support our mission and vision.
- Lead our *Next Steps* programming, which is intended to foster discipleship connections and pathways that edify and equip current and new members, new converts, and seekers.
- Lead the administration of church operations, which includes supervising/equipping professional office staff and engaging other ministers and members in the execution of operational functions that support various ministries.
- Coordinate and contribute to our current and potential community outreach and digital programming, most of which have volunteer leaders and members.
- Coordinate our adult education program by securing teachers and materials; teach multiple times per year.
- Coordinate the scheduling and execution of all worship services, other church gatherings, and community-sponsored events in our facilities.
- Other duties as assigned.

Key Skills and/or Experiences:

- Biblically grounded and committed to Jesus Christ and sharing His gospel.
- Bachelor's degree or similar in Ministry, Communications, or related field is preferred.
- A record of 3 or more years of successful experience in connections, involvement, or administrative ministry is preferred.
- Ability to demonstrate strong leadership and organizational qualities and behaviors.
- Ability to work independently and in teams.
- Ability to engage in and foster relationships with diverse peoples.
- Ability to communicate interpersonally, with groups, and via technology.
- Ability to utilize digital systems, such as church management software.

- This is a paid, full-time position that reports directly to the shepherds.
- Compensation is commensurate with qualifications and experience.
- Monday-Friday office hours that allow reasonable flexibility plus weekend and evening responsibilities are expectations of the position.
