A MESSAGE FROM THE ELDERS:

In his inaugural address, delivered Jan 20, 1961, President John F. Kennedy proclaimed that "... here on earth, God's work must truly be our own." His speech was a powerful call to action, urging citizens to engage in making the world a better place.

In a similar way, God is calling his people to action today in order to spread his kingdom. And while the spreading of God's kingdom certainly makes the world a better place, it also – and more importantly - leads to the eternal salvation and happiness of all who believe. President Kennedy's goal was to motivate people to work for the common good. But you and I ARE God's work as the following passages of scripture attest.

"For we are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works..." (Eph 2:10)

"I just hope to have stable housing and a stable place; a place where I can be happy and be me." Jess was happy to share that she is now a resident of Evergreen Brightstart, a transitional housing program in Bremerton, where she has found easy access to work and community support. "They have a lot of little events to get to know each other and activities. We did painting pots and origami. We have movie nights... I have connections with one of the resident managers. We have another case manager we can meet with weekly to talk about how we're feeling and what we plan to do and update on our life." We are greatly encouraged by Jess' perseverance!
