## A MESSAGE FROM THE ELDERS:

"You are what you eat". We've all heard the saying and been encouraged to eat healthy food. But did you also know that you are what you think? Many authors, specialists and motivational speakers make a good living trying to get others to think positively. But you don't really need to read their books or attend their seminars. We already have everything we need to live positively. The Bible is the most positive book in the world; and the church is the most positive system. Together, they tell us that we are made in God's image and, as children of God, instruct us how to think and how to live.

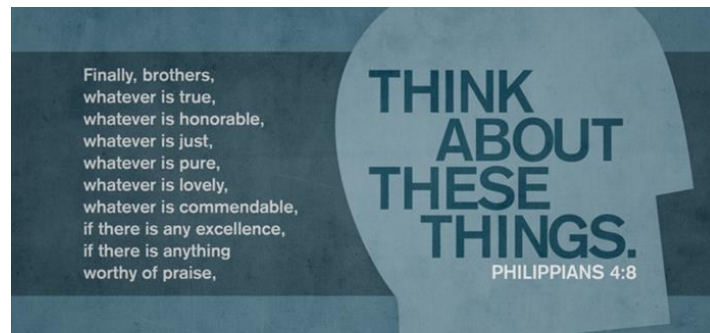
Consider the life impact of just one Biblical principle – that of first-fruits. The principle is that we offer God the first and the best of everything he's blessed us with.

· So if we're beginning the week, we offer him the first day by gathering with the church and encouraging one another. And along the way, we learn to be encouragers.

· If we're beginning a new day, we spend time with God in prayer and reflect on his words in the Bible. And along the way, we learn to examine ourselves and to focus on becoming more like God.

· When our activities are profitable, we give a portion of our profits to the LORD. And along the way, we learn to be thankful and generous.

What parent doesn't want these things for their children? And if these qualities are good for children, they are good for parents as well. So, give God your first and your best. That may be the only motivational strategy you need to become a more positive thinker – and a better person along the way.

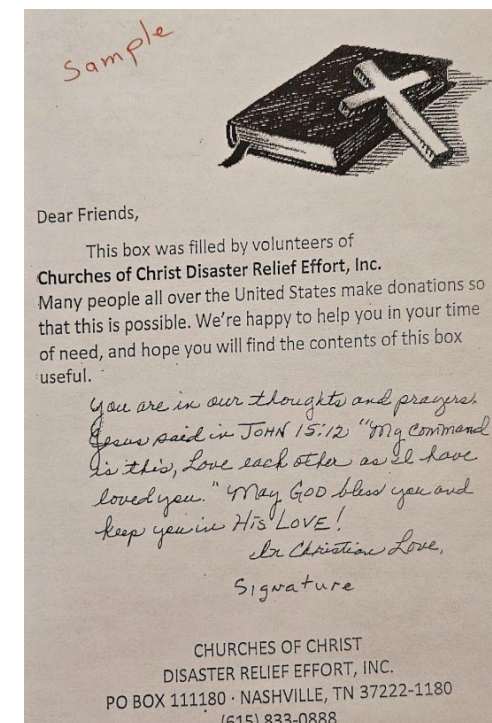

## MISSION CORNER:



Dale Lingey, Associate Director of Development for Churches of Christ Disaster Relief Effort, Inc., is requesting that the members of Central Kitsap Church of Christ help with writing 600 encouraging notes to the victims of natural disasters. They supply these individuals and families with necessities and Bibles that contain these notes. These Bibles each contain a handwritten note of encouragement inside them. Here is an example of one of the notes included in the Bible:



The written portion of the message is generic and does not specify any type of disaster since these notes are given to people in various circumstances as need arises. Each person in each family should fill them out (not just the mom). You will find the empty templates on your bench each week until the mission is completed. Please place them back where you found them for pick up when you are finished.

**Goal:** Help those in need as we are commanded in God's Word, build relationship between a local Church of Christ & the families in that community they are helping after the disaster they've just been through, plant a seed that God can cause to grow in the hearts of the lost so they want to learn more about God's Word, organize studies with the church that helped them, salvation!
