A MESSAGE FROM THE ELDERS:

During the month of September, we will be exploring Christian Community. 1 Peter 2:9 "But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people belonging to God, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light."

Peter never uses the word "church" in referring to these people, but other New Testament writers do. The word "church" has the meaning of those called out. We have been called out of the world to show God through his son Christ Jesus. Paul and John both use the word church to reference a group of believers worshiping together in a geographical location. Examples of this are: the church in Jerusalem and the church in Ephesus. We are the church in Central Kitsap.

Paul writes in Romans 12 "Just as each of us has one body with many members, and these members do not all have the same function, so in Christ we who are many form one body, and each member belongs to all the others. We have different gifts, according to the grace given us."

The takeaway for the first week in September, we are all important together in the church to demonstrate the Kingdom of God!
