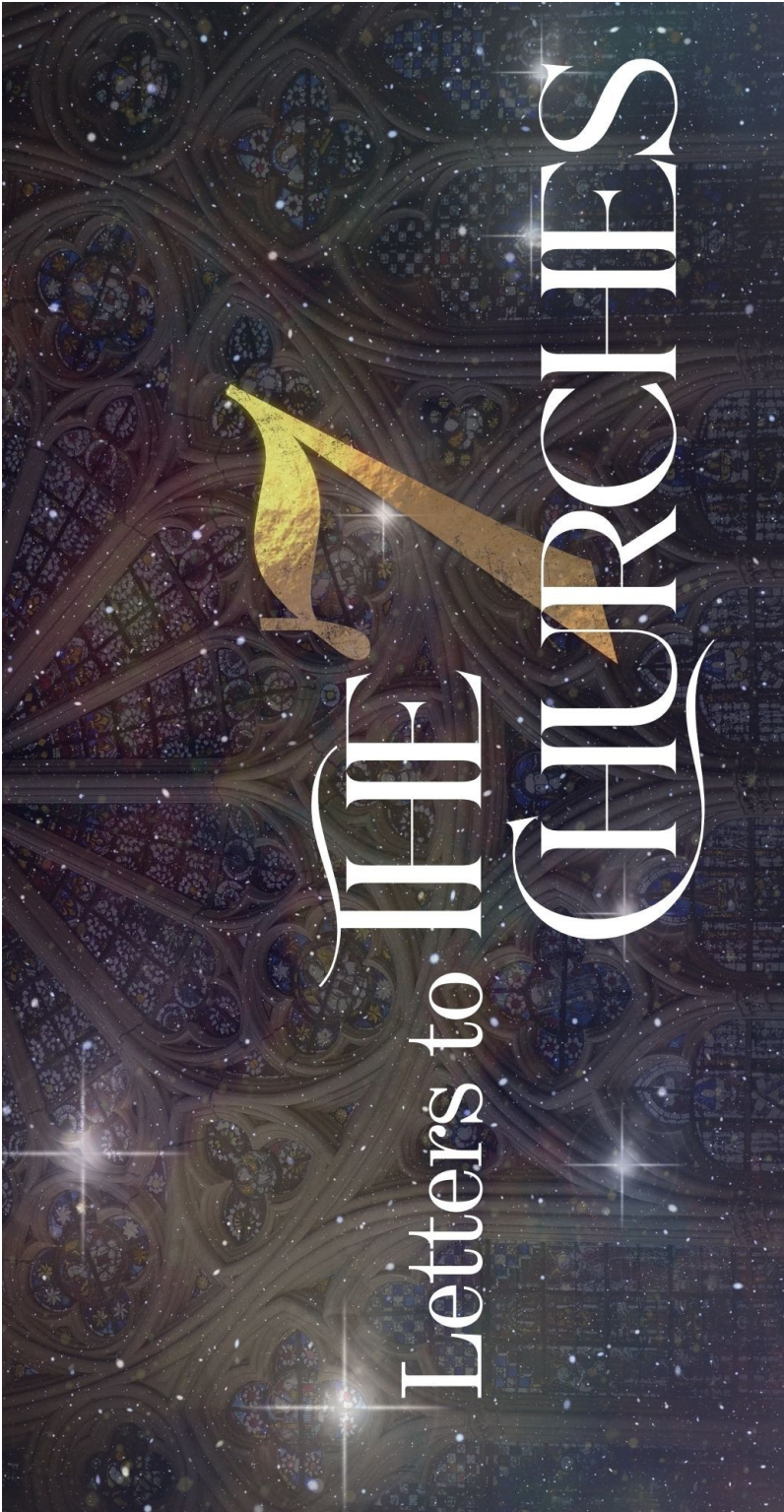

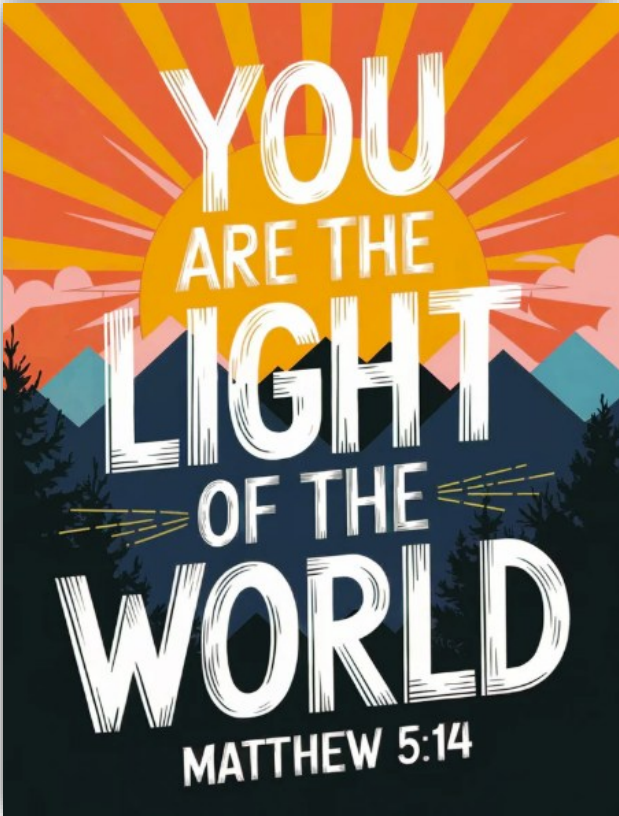
**A MESSAGE FROM THE ELDERS:**
