## A MESSAGE FROM THE ELDERS:

Joy

Joy. It's a simple, single syllable, three letter word that describes or is related to some happy emotion. Joy may be someone's name, or joy may be used as a descriptor to suggest a pleasurable or blissful physical sensation, i.e. the satisfaction one might obtain by consuming an *Almond Joy* candy bar or being overcome with *tears of joy* at the sounds of a newborn child.

Webster defines JOY as an emotion of well-being, success or good fortune; the prospect of possessing what one desires; a state of happiness or bliss; a source of pure delight.

Scripture encourages us to be joyful, to sing joyful songs, to fill one's heart with glad thoughts, to celebrate joyfully, to take joy in the heavenly hope that is Christ Jesus our Lord.

Though the word JOY describes something so wonderful, it can be fragile and at risk of being lost. So, what are some of the things that place joy at risk?

Sadness. Some respond to seasons of sadness, stress, or distress by distancing themselves from God. But it is in such times that one needs to draw closer to him in order that one might be uplifted by his comforting spirit.

A controlling mindset. One's overwhelming need to be in control often results in frustration or even anger. The truth is that there are so many things that occur that are completely beyond one's control. Trust in God in all circumstances, good or bad fosters, joy even in the difficult times.

Comparison. Comparison is the thief of joy because it fosters feelings of inadequacy and self-doubt, which can lead to a downward spiral of negative self-talk. God knows our capabilities. He knows everything about us, our abilities, limitations, wants, wishes, and needs. Think less about what you want and consider what you have to offer. Instead of agonizing about one's negative feelings, follow Jesus' example of caring for others with the gifts you've been given, which not only aides the other, but also promotes positive feelings of self-worth and happiness.
